



City of Hollywood's Adopt-A-Catch-Basin Volunteer Program

What is a catch basin?

A catch basin is a drain that collects stormwater from streets and transports it to local waterways via underground infrastructure.

Why Should I adopt a catch basin?

Catch basins are put in place to prevent flooding. Unfortunately, they can become clogged with debris, trash, or litter before, after, or during a rain event. Keeping them clean helps prevent neighborhoods from flooding and local surface waters from being polluted.

How can I adopt a catch basin?

Select a catch basin/storm drain in close proximity to your residence

Complete the Adopt-A-Catch Basin application.

Perform periodical or as-needed inspection/cleaning of the adopted catch basin

Submit proof of maintenance to AdoptACatchBasin@hollywoodfl.org.

Points will be assigned to each maintenance activity.

At the end of the 12-month, the catch basins with the most points will receive various City-approved incentives for correctly adhering to and following the program guidelines.
